



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Who will be awarded the prize?

The full-time final year student enrolled on a BSc(Hons) degree programme within the cognate area of Computing that has the highest level 3 aggregate mark.

How much is the prize and how will I receive it?

The annual prize amount is currently £100. You will receive a cheque drawn in your favour either in person or by post shortly after the Award Ceremony at which you graduate. You will also receive a certificate marking the occasion.

Do I need to do anything to “claim” it?

No. The appropriate Award Board will notify Revell Research Systems that you have received the prize.

Is the prize available indefinitely?

Revell Research Systems has made the prize available definitely until Academic Year 2015-2016. The practice will make a decision whether to extend its availability for a further period in that year.

What’s the benefit of winning the prize?

The prime benefit (other than some cash!) is that you will be easily able to highlight that you were the best performing student in your year in any BSc(Hons) programme within the cognate area of Computing. It is the sort of thing that you can easily put on your Curriculum Vitae and mention when applying to prospective employers.

If I win the prize, what can I spend the money on?

You can spend the money on anything you want! We would hope you might spend it wisely on something of value to your career rather than on a few beers, but we place no restrictions on its use!
